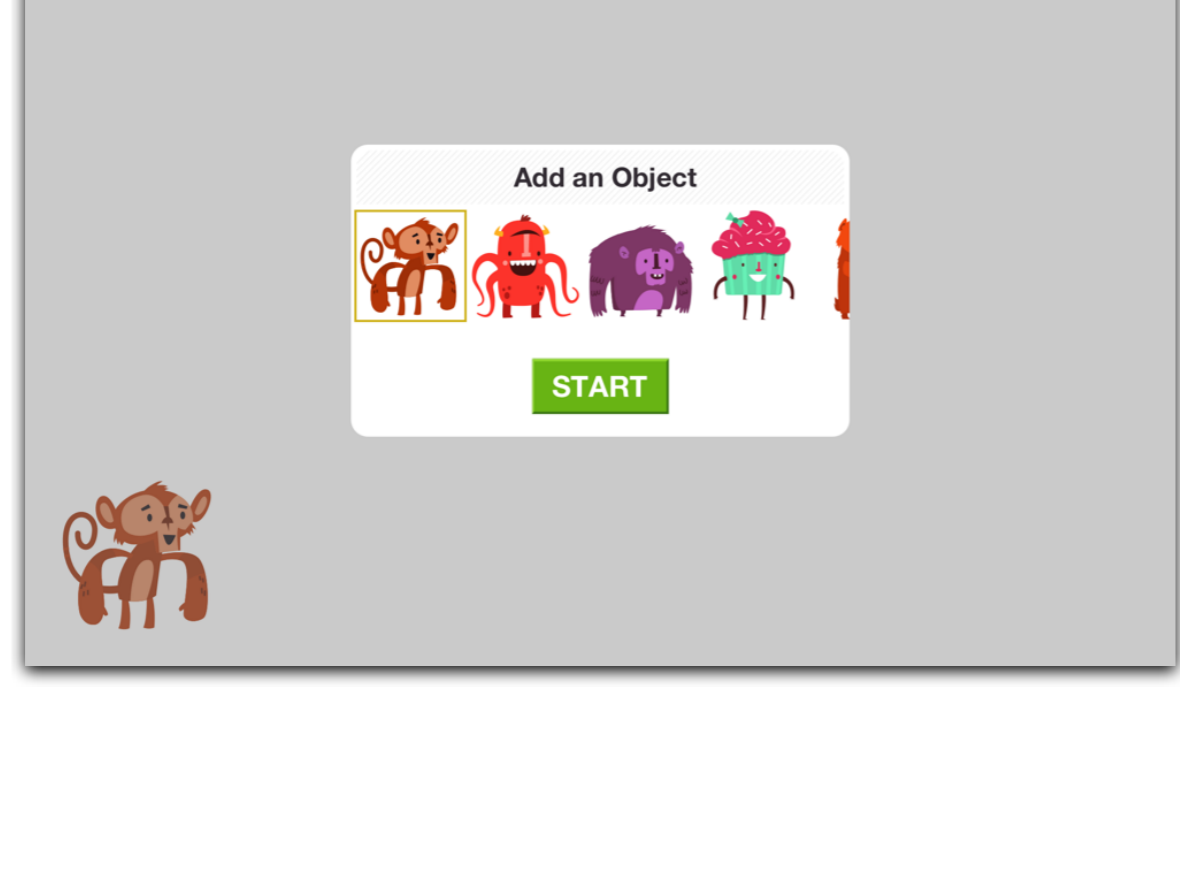




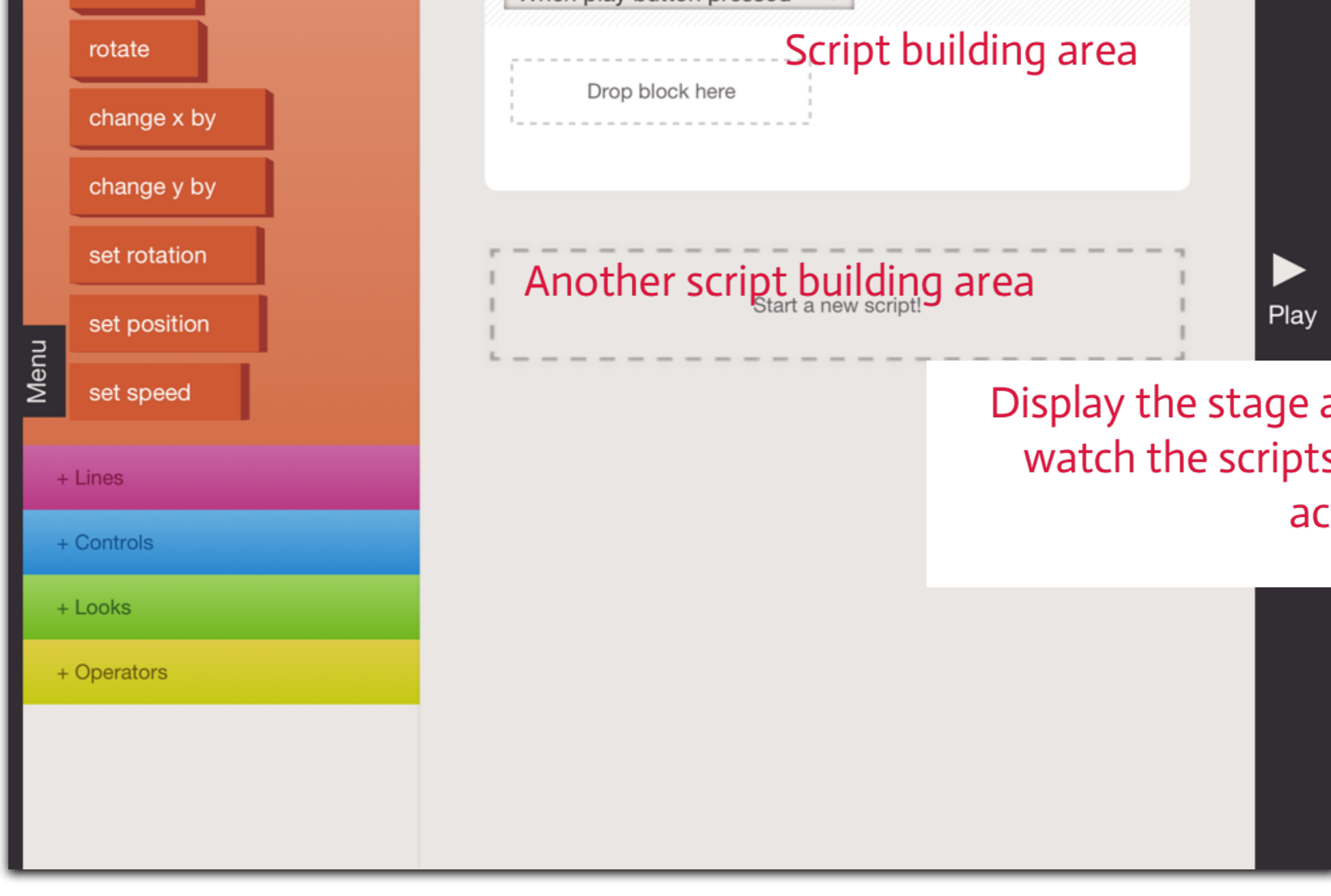
This is a beautifully designed app, which is an excellent way for younger children to learn the basic skills of programming. Although it looks simple and lacks the bells and whistles of Scratch, it can be used to create some quite complex and imaginative programs. It has been well thought out and is intuitive to use. Hopscotch could well be used as a precursor to Scratch, because all the skills can be easily transferred. Children - and adults who are new to programming - won't be overwhelmed.
