Walk to School Week and Happy Shoesday

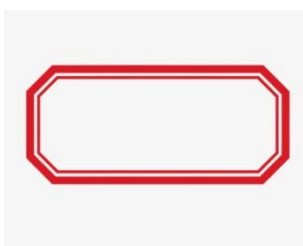
