Thank you to everyone who was able to join us for our Easter assembly this morning. Children from Year 2 and Year 5 shared their assembly with parents and the rest of the school

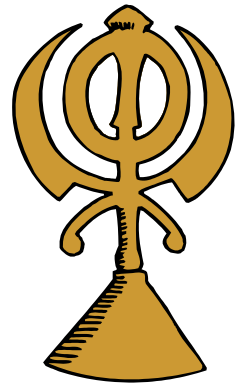
