## Ofsted Inspection

As you already know the school had an Ofsted inspection yesterday and Wednesday. A team of four inspectors were in school on both days monitoring and evaluating all aspects of the school's provision. While they were here they observed lessons in all classes, spoke to the children, looked
 at children's work, visited Breakfast Club, spoke with parents, met with governors, looked at the responses on Parent View, reviewed the school's own self-evaluation and school improvement planning, met with the school's leadership team, sampled Jody's school lunches, spoke to our local authority adviser and gathered all the evidence they need to make a judgement about the quality of education children receive at our school. The inspection went smoothly and we enjoyed having an opportunity to show the inspectors our school. We should receive the inspection report in January. Copies of the report will be emailed home to parents as soon as we receive it. The report will also be published on the Ofsted website.
