4. Cross next to name

5. Lunchtime reflection

6. Work in isolation

7. Sent to partner class

8. Sent to Year Leader / Acting Head Teacher or Head Teacher

9. Yellow card (one off or cumulative)

10. Red card (three yellows in one term)

For <u>SERIOUS</u> Incidents . . .

1. Lunchtime reflection

2. Yellow card (one off or cumulative)

3. Red card = Exclusion ~ fixed (internally or external) or permanent
