

## **Service Level Agreement:**

The offer: 3 days per school
Termly co-ordinator meetings
Regular updates via email and newsletter.

The Cost: £1200

If 3 or more schools purchase as a group, each school will be entitled to one twilight CPD session in addition to the 3 days. (Twilights are normally charged at £195).

Schools purchasing as a group decide their time allocation collaboratively. A possible model is that schools keep 1.5 days per school and allocate the remaining 1.5 to joint CPD activities. However, the precise allocation of time will be decided by the group.

Schools may opt to use their time allocation for such things as: in-class support, lead lessons, curriculum planning, mobile learning implementation, and consultation or Governing Body briefings.

There will also be a termly co-ordinators' meeting.

The course programme will be a range of half day/twilight courses to further the schools' eLearning capability whether this is focussing on staff CPD requirements or developing some of your pupils to become Digital Leaders.
