Attendance & Punctuality.

We have seen a positive start of the new school year. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time daily to avoid disruption – the school day starts at 8.50am and teaching and learning begins immediately. From the first day your child is off school please inform us of the reason absence and every day after as it helps to keep our registers up to date. If we do not hear from you by 9.15am on the first day of absence, school will contact you to find out why your child is off. If your child's attendance falls below 95%, their progress could be seriously affected. Our Education Welfare Officer Mr S Jones is monitoring Attendance very closely this term as our overall percentage last year was only 86%. He will be contacting all parents whose child's attendance drops below 90% - this is a new initiative by Neath Port Talbot Council.

Time spent in school and learning is very important.

Breakfast Club
