- Help pupils recognise the importance of family support for them and for the school.
- Help parents and the school to feel at ease with each other.
- Create opportunity for practical involvement of parents and local community in the life of the school.
- Encourage positive thinking about the strong home-school links; develop new ideas and strategies for improving these links.
