Ongoing possibility of closure

The school has implemented a wide range of measures to ensure the school is a Covid-safe environment. This includes increased handwashing and sanitisation, ongoing cleaning schedules throughout the day, staggered playtimes and lunchtimes, the wearing of masks by all adults in school and contact groups being kept as small as possible.

Should the school receive notification of a positive case within a contact group (either adult or pupil), the whole contact group will be contacted by TTP to self-isolate. Please help keep our pupils back in school by not mixing out of school hours. Pupils are frequently telling staff of friends coming over to play, etc. The Local Authority will fully support the school if it becomes necessary to ask pupils not to attend for this reason.
