We brushed and weeded and washed and sorted. Now it looks fantastic!

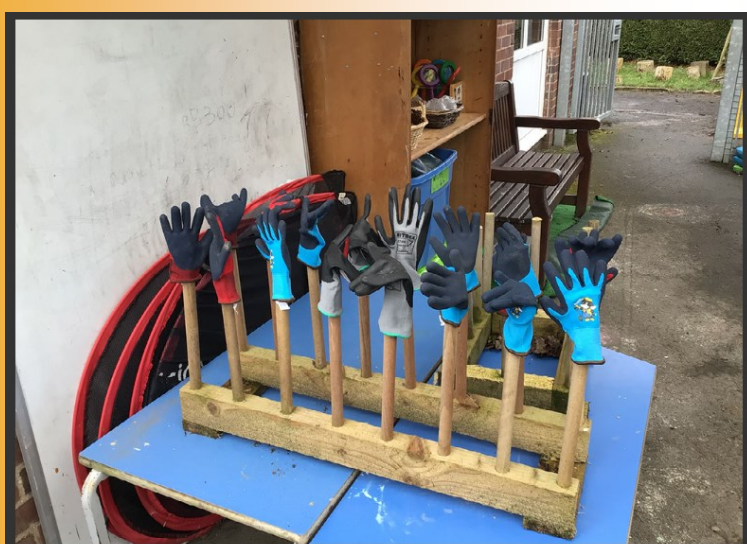






We refilled the bird feeders. We love spotting all the birds who come to visit the garden.
