Planting Bulbs for Spring



Collen are taking part in the 'Spring Bulbs for School' investigation. As part of the investigation, we have to make daily records of rainfall and temperature. Today we learned how to measure the temperature on a thermometer and the rainfall in the gauge.



To get ready for the spring bulbs experiment, we tipped out last years pots and replanted the bulbs in the borders. Then we used the soil to fill the gaps at the side of the playground. We also tidied up other plant pots.



Then it was time to plant our bulbs! We filled the bottom of the pot with leaves, then added a layer of compost. We placed in the daffodil and crocus bulb and topped up the pot with soil.
