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## Language, Literacy and Communication

This term as part of our 'Adventurers and Explorers' topic, we will be learning how to write a journey story. Our non-fiction focus will be description and dialogue, with a focus on rhyming couplets in Poetry.

Our Oracy focus for this term will be to develop our performing skills for our class play.

## Cymraeg

We will be learning all about 'discussing plans and activities', we will be able to plan events and discuss them in Welsh. We will also be looking at 'describing events from the past'.

## Curriculum Focus for this term

### Explorers and Adventurers

Our learning this term will focus on 'Explorers and Adventurers'. We will look at a variety of explorers from the past and modern day adventurers. If restrictions allow we are also planning a visit to Castell Henllys at the end of term.

We have our class play 'Let the games begin' at the end of this half-term, the pupils are so enthusiastic and can't wait to share it with you.

## Mathematics and Numeracy

This term we will be busy consolidating our knowledge of place value. Our focus will be:

- Multiplication and division (2,3,4,5,6 and 10 times table)
  - Measurement – Money
  - Number Fractions
  - Number – Decimals
  - Statistics
  - Measurement – Volume
  - Measurement – Weight
  - Geometry – Movement

Problem solving activities will be used across the curriculum to embed the skills across the curriculum.

## Religious Education

The children will follow the Come and See themes; we start with the 'Community' where the children will explore our local 'Community.'

We will then focus on 'Giving and Receiving', looking at how important it is to be thoughtful to others and learn about the Eucharist.

Our virtues this term will focus on 'Intentional and Prophetic' through our Awesome Actions of 'Relationships'. Following on from that we will be looking at the virtues 'Grateful and Generous' and our Awesome Action will be 'Fantastic Friendships.'

## Health and Wellbeing

We will continue to have sessions with Swansea City Football Club on a Wednesday afternoon. We will also be having swimming lessons every Monday morning. Pupils will need to wear PE kit on Monday and Wednesday this term.

This term we will continue to follow the 'Life to the Full' programme. We will continue to look at 'Me, My Body, My Health.'
