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Language, Literacy and Communication

In literacy, we will be reading the following stories to support our learning linked to our topic

- Brian Bear's Picnic
- Traction Man

We will also develop oracy skills through Talk4Writing and Voice21 and continue with Read. Write. Inc for our phonics lessons.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

We will be looking at what toys are made out of and experimenting with the properties of a variety of materials. We will investigate materials that float or sink, are magnetic/non magnetic and if they are waterproof/not waterproof. We will also be learning about how toys have changed over time.

Physical Development
