Department of Curriculum – Wales Outdoor Learning Week

Our pupils thoroughly enjoyed getting involved with Wales Outdoor Learning Week last week.

In the Foundation Phase, Dosbarth Solve and Dosbarth Amroth enjoyed foraging for ingredients in the outdoor area to follow a recipe for a "Mud pie" in the mud kitchen. Dosbarth Little Haven went outside to take part in a scavenger hunt to find things in nature that were 'bumpy', 'smooth', 'crunchy' and lots more! They also worked with Dosbarth Marloes to create their own spring themed artwork using natural resources.

Dosbarth Little Haven and Marloes also enjoyed a half day session in the wooded area. They started with a collective worship, being grateful for the gift of nature that God has given us. They then went on to identify signs of spring and use classification cards to try and name what they found.

Key Stage 2 took some of their maths, science and Welsh learning outdoors. In Welsh, Dosbarth Newgale enjoyed working with a partner to design a new warm up game for PE. Dosbarth Druidston had a creative morning in the woodland area making weatherproof shelters from natural materials (and a bit of tarpaulin!) for their explorers, they then tested them against the 'wind' and the 'rain' to see if they worked. Dosbarth Aberiddy designed and created their own catapults and then went outdoors to test to see which group's catapult travelled the furthest!
