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Language, Literacy and Communication

This term we will be continuing with our 'Talk for Writing' process, we will be applying the skills that we have previously learnt throughout the year as well as learning new techniques to write a 'finding' story. Our focus will be to create 'mystery and suspense.' Our non-fiction focus will be 'instructions and explanation,' with a focus on Haiku Poetry.

Curriculum focus for this term

Do we help or hinder God's creatures?

Mathematics and Numeracy

This term we our focus will be:

- Decimals including number bonds to 100.
 - Measurement – Money
 - Measurement - Time
 - Statistics
 - Properties of shape
 - Measurement – Weight
 - Geometry – position and direction
 - Times Tables (2,3,4,5,6,7 and 10)
- Problem solving activities will be used across the curriculum to embed the skills across the curriculum.

The children will follow the Come and See themes; we start with the 'New Life' where the children will explore 'Pentecost' and 'Serving.'

We will then focus on 'Building Bridges', looking at 'Reconciliation' and 'Inter-relating.'
