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Language, Literacy and Communication

This term our class novel will be The Explorer by Katherine Rundell and we will also be reading The Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry to inspire the following literacy tasks:

- *Poetry – Free Verse, use of poetic devices, expressive language
- *Explanation text
- *Dialogue
- *Information Portrait

We will also be using Talk4Writing and Oracy 21 to further enhance our Literacy skills.

We will be exploring this topic across the curriculum linking in Science, Geography, Welsh and Art, and the teaching will support the development of Literacy, Numeracy and ICT skills. Mathematical Development

This term we will be focusing on the following numeracy skills:

- Measurement – Length, perimeter, area, volume, weight
- Using mental strategies to recall multiplication tables and using this knowledge to solve division problems
- Data skills - mean, median, mode and range
- Fractions, percentage, decimals and ratio
- Functions - use multistep function machines to generate input and output using all four operations

Welsh Language Development

- 'Dewch I Gymru' will be our focus in our Welsh lessons during the term. We will look at the attractions Wales has to offer, and prepare a voice over for an advertisement for visitors to Wales in Welsh
- In addition to our weekly Welsh lessons, the children will also be involved in reading sessions throughout the week to support their Welsh language development.
- We will also prepare for our virtual eisteddfod

Science
