

# Dosbarth Little Haven Curriculum Letter Summer 2023

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## Language, Literacy and Communication

This term in literacy, we will learn a wishing tale - The Magic Brush. We will use Talk4Writing actions and a story map to help remember and recall the story. We will also be creating a non-fiction persuasive piece of work linked to our topic. We will also use Voice21 actions to further enhance literacy skills.

We will be continuing to develop the children's Welsh skills through the Welsh phonics scheme 'Tric a Chlic' and daily 'Slot Drilio' sessions. We will use the Fflic a Fflac continuum of work to learn prepositions in Welsh. We will be learning to ask and answer questions about where we would like to go. We will also be asking for and paying for different food items and saying what we like and don't like to eat.

## Health and Wellbeing

During PE this term we will be following the Real PE scheme. The children will be developing their personal skills through fun games whilst continuing to develop their fundamental movement skills with a focus on co-ordination and balance. The children will also continue to have their weekly outdoor learning session.

## Religious Education

The children will be taught the Come and See themes based on the Church, Sacrament and Christian living. They will explore the following topics and big questions:

**Holidays and holydays** – Do we need holidays and holydays?

**Being Sorry** – Why should we be sorry?

**Neighbours** – Who is my neighbour?

**Our virtues this term will be Curious and Active and Intentional & Prophetic**

## Maths and Numeracy

Throughout the term we will continue to develop the children's mental arithmetic skills through mental maths activities.

We will start the term learning about multiplication before moving onto division and fractions. We will also be consolidating our learning on place value.

We will be learning about mass and money in authentic contexts through our topic work.

## Topic

We will be exploring this topic across all areas of learning; expressive arts, science and technology, humanities, and health and wellbeing. The teaching will support the development of literacy, numeracy and digital skills.

Throughout this topic, the children will be at the centre of their learning in planning what they would like to find out. They have expressed an interest in learning more about some of the different jobs available in Haverfordwest and have raised a number of questions already. We will be arranging visits so that the children can find out more about the opportunities in the world of work in our community.
