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<u>Language, Literacy and</u> <u>Communication</u>

In literacy, learners will have the opportunity to write a warning tale. This will be based upon our model text 'The Caravan.' Children also work on discussions and persuasion. In poetry we will look at free verse poetry. We will also be using Talk4Writing and Voice 21 to further enhance our literacy skills. Our class book this term will be Jaz Santos V The World written by Priscilla Mante.

This term, we will be continuing to use the Welsh continuum in our weekly Welsh lessons. We will be focusing on describing the weather, location and places. In addition to our weekly lessons, the children will be involved in daily oracy sessions throughout the week to support their Welsh language development.
