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Language, Literacy and Communication

Throughout our literacy, learners will have the opportunity to write a 5-part suspense story and an information text. We will explore a variety of poetry techniques. We will also be using Talk4Writing and Voice 21 to further enhance our literacy skills. **Our class book this term will be ' Pig Heart Boy' which we started at the end of last term.**

This term, we will be using the Welsh continuum in our weekly Welsh lessons. Our focus this term will be on expressing an opinion and discussing arrangements. In addition to our weekly lessons, the children will also be involved in daily oracy and reading sessions throughout the week to support their Welsh language development.

This term, we will continue with Spanish sessions with our learners in line with Curriculum for Wales.

Curriculum Focus for this term

The World and I

Our enquiry questions for this term have been generated by pupil voice.

1. How can I help my community?
2. How have my actions impacted the world?
3. What difference can I make?

Religious Education

The pupils will be taught Come and See themes based on the Church, Sacrament and Christian living. The children will explore the following topics and big questions:

Witnesses - What do I want to witness to in my life?

Healing – Who needs healing?

Common Good - How can we work together to build a just and fair world?

Our virtues this term will be Curious and Wise and Intentional and Prophetic.

Maths and Numeracy

Throughout the term we will continue to develop the children's mental arithmetic skills and knowledge of the four operations.

This term we will be focusing on:

- Algebra
- 3D shapes
- Function Machines and Algebra
- Finding the Nth term – Number Sequences
- 3D nets
- Area
- Timetables
- Probability

Topic

We will be exploring our topic across all areas of learning; expressive arts, science and technology, humanities, and health and wellbeing. The teaching throughout the term will support the development of literacy, numeracy and digital skills.

Throughout this topic, the children will be at the centre of their learning in planning what they would like to find out. They have expressed an interest in learning about how we can help our community, the impact of our actions on the world and our community and the importance of charity work.
