Language, Literacy and Communication

Throughout our literacy, learners will have the opportunity to write a 5-part portal story and an explanation text. We will explore a variety of poetry techniques. We will also be using Talk4Writing and Voice 21 to further enhance our literacy skills.

Our class book this term will be 'The Extraordinary Colours of Auden Dare'.

This term, we will be using the Welsh continuum in our Welsh lessons. Our focus this term will be on describing past events and expressing an opinion. In addition to our lessons, the children will also be involved in daily oracy and reading sessions throughout the week to support their Welsh language development.

This term, we will continue to introduce Spanish to our learners in line with Curriculum for Wales.
