





# This is the sport's page where you get all the news related to sports.


Now the world cup is coming up,

# TRICK OR EAT.

#### HALLOWEEN CHEESECAKE

Ingredients
300g of Oreos
100g butter (melted)
125g icing sugar
3 x 280g of cream cheese
50g white chocolate
300ml double cream
Method

- 1. Line the baking tray.
- 2. In a large bowl crush up the biscuits with a rolling pin
- 3. Melt butter in the microwave and pour the butter in with the biscuits and press into the tin.
- 4. Whip the cream cheese, icing sugar and vanilla bean paste.
- 5. In another bowl whisk the cream till soft then fold into the cheese mixture.
- 6. Put aside 50g of the mixture in the fridge.
- 7. Spoon the rest of the mixture onto the biscuit base and spread smoothly with a spatula or spoon. Place in the fridge for a couple hours to set.
- 8. Now take the cheese mixture out of the fridge to go to room temperature.
- 9. Melt the white chocolate in a microwave then leave for 5 mins and mix in the cheese mixture.
- 10. Spoon in a piping bag with a small round nozzle and decorate the cake as you wish


We have held lunchlime concerts (pre-COVID), and have organised an online event during the lockdown. We're looking forward to creating lots more opportunities for pupils to perform.




