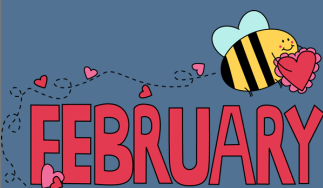

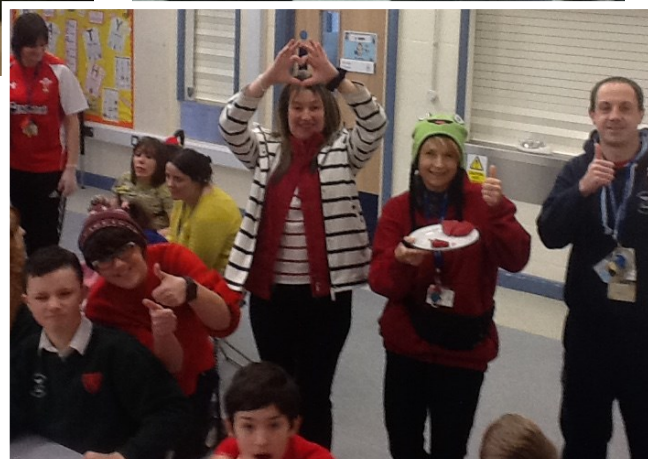


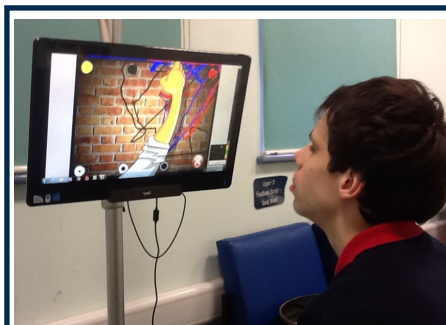

A HUGE thank you to everyone who has donated so far towards installing a Defibrillator at Portfield School!

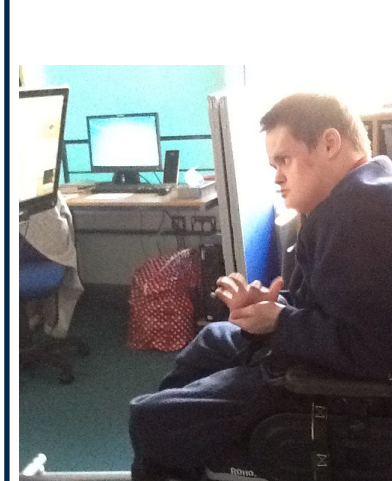




Upper 5 have been using the eye gaze to create pictures about Wales and play musical instruments during
