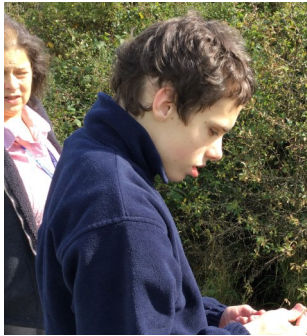

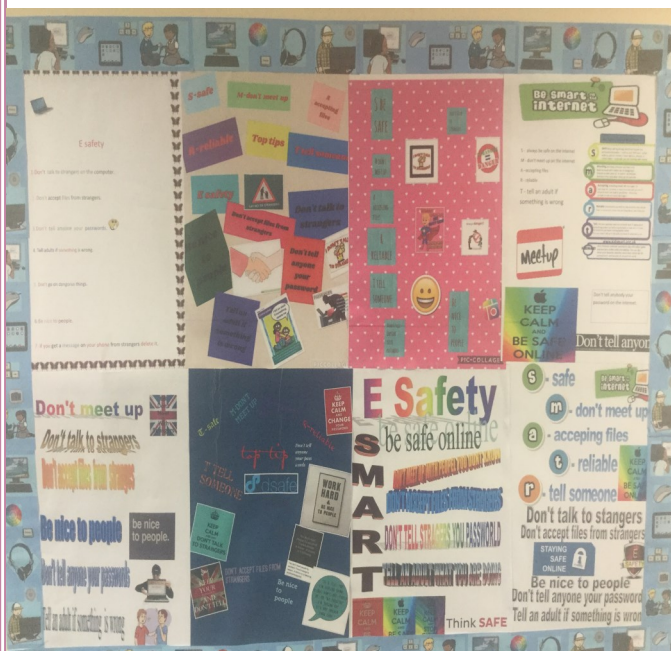
Upper 5 have been making apple crumbles and going on Autumn Rambles.
