2. OR go to J2E on internet on the PC.



4. Sign in with your Hwb username and password.

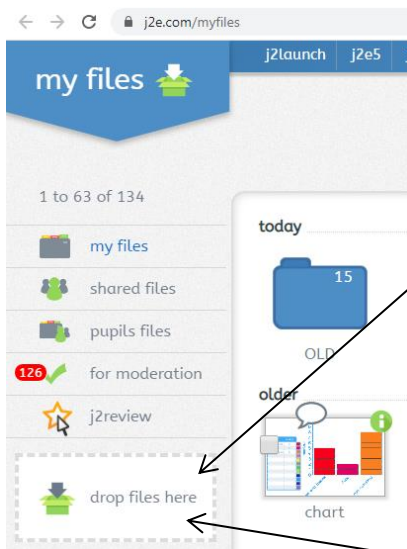
