



Shrove Tuesday - Pancake Day

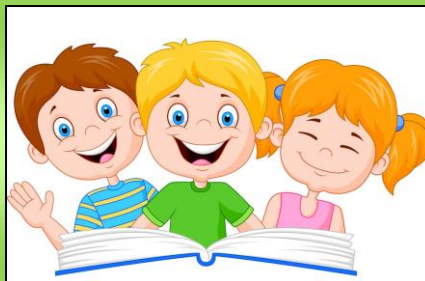
- Discuss Shrove Tuesday and why it is important to Christians.
- Pupils to create a list of ingredients needed and follow instructions to make.
- Select toppings they would like by cutting out pictures and placing on a pancake template.
- Pupils to sequence how they made pancakes.
- Show results using tables (favourite pancake toppings) and graphs (pictogram/bar).
- Pupils to attend a Pancake Café - paying for pancakes, selecting toppings whilst socialising with pupils from other classes.

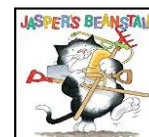
KS2 - Seahorse Class

Jasper and the Beanstalk Activities:

- Make a scene from the story in a shoebox using different materials.
- Planting - planting different beans.

- Label parts of a plant.
- Measure plants using standard and non-standard units.

Share a story

- Share Pie Corbett story with others/in the hall.
- Share the story with a different class using their shoe boxes to help retell the scene.

Pie-Corbett Story Telling

- Listen to the story.
- Re-tell the story.
- Identify and use actions from the story.
- Draw a story map containing the main points.
- Use the story map to 'walk along' the story and retell the key points.
- Draw/sequence images to create an individual story map.
- Pupils to rewrite the story/ parts of the story.

- Following a recipe to make Welsh cakes.
