

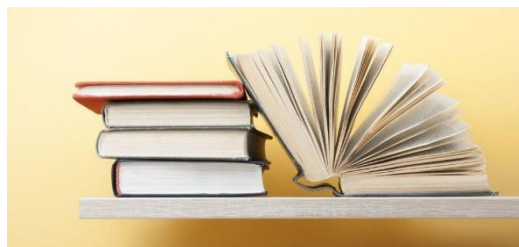


Reading - The more you read the more you know. - Key Stage 4
