NUMBER: CAN YOUR CHILD?.....

Count on/back in 10's or 100's starting from any 2 or 3 digit numbers.

Read and write numbers to at least 1000 in numerals & words.

Know the value of each digit in a 3 digit number eg 246 = (200 + 40 + 6)

Order whole numbers to 1,000.

Understand division and multiplying.

Know by heart: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10 and 11 times tables.

Know doubles of numbers to 10 and doubles of 25, 50.

All addition and subtraction facts for each number to 20.

Recognise 2D and 3D shapes

Add and take away amounts of money using decimal notation.

Begin to work out half or third of an amount.
