

Treowen Primary School Code of Conduct for Parents and Carers

In order to promote a safe and peaceful environment that enables the effective support of pupil and staff wellbeing, parents and carers who enrol their child into the school agree to the following:-

Ready

Your child needs to be ready to learn. They should arrive on time with the items required for the day. Staff need to be ready for class – use the handover time to pass on pertinent information for the day ahead, such as a change of going home arrangements. Make a separate appointment via the office for any concerns or topics that require a lengthier discussion.

Do not hold staff up in the mornings - they need to be in class for a day of excellent teaching.

Respectful

All conversations must be respectful. Raised voices, profanity/swearing, gesturing and anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated.

Any concerns or complaints must be raised through the correct procedure. A complaint policy is available on the school website.

The posting of comments on social media about the school, its staff or other families/pupils is not an appropriate method of dealing with a concern.

Safe

All pupils, staff and families have a right to feel safe.

No person or child on site should witness negative or undesirable behaviour in others. Intimidating, aggressive, threatening, racist or intoxicated behaviour will be referred to the appropriate authorities. This may include the police or social services.

The above expectations refer to the physical school site and its resources, all communications (including face to face meetings, telephone and email) and all use of social media/electronic communication.

In appropriate cases, the school are able to refuse a person entry to the school grounds.
