

Cynllun GDD Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais 2021-22

Dyrennir y Grant Datblygu Disgyblion i ysgolion sydd â disgyblion sy'n dod o deuluoedd incwm isel ac y gwyddys eu bod ar hyn o bryd yn gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim (e-FSM) a disgyblion sydd wedi derbyn gofal yn barhaus am fwy na chwe mis (LAC).

Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim neu sy'n LAC.

Fel ysgol rydym wedi cytuno ar y tri cham a ganlyn:

1. nodi'r grŵp targed o ddisgyblion, eu nodweddion a'u hanghenion
2. cynllunio ymyraethau sy'n gwneud y defnydd mwyaf effeithiol o adnoddau
3. monitro a gwerthuso effaith adnoddau

Yn 2021-22 rhoddwyd £10,350 i Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais fel dyraniad o'r Grant Datblygu Disgyblion (£5750 GDD a £4600 GDD Blynyddoedd Cynnar).

Yn Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais mae gennym gynllun cynhwysfawr, sydd wedi'i gytuno a'i fonitro gan Awdurdod Lleol Nedd a Phort Talbot, i hyrwyddo cynnydd a lleihau rhwystrau dysgu i ddisgyblion sy'n gymwys ar gyfer y cyllid hwn.

Rydym wedi defnyddio'r cyllid i:

- ddarparu rhaglenni ymyrraeth a chymorth y profwyd eu bod yn cael yr effaith fwyaf ac yn gynaliadwy – Rhaglenni ELSA a Maeth.
- datblygu capasiti o fewn yr ysgol i flaenoriaethu'r effaith ar ansawdd y ddarpariaeth a'r canlyniadau

Amcanion effaith y camau uchod fydd:

- Gwella cefnogaeth i ddisgyblion a theuluoedd wedi'u targedu trwy ymyrraeth.
- Gwell lles ac ymddygiad disgyblion sydd wedi'u targedu.
- Darparu gwell mynediad i gwricwlwm cyfoethog ar gyfer disgyblion.

Mae ein cynllun, sy'n cynnwys manylion mewn perthynas â sut rydym yn gwario'r grant yn dilyn.

Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais PDG Plan

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (e-FSM) and pupils who have been looked after continuously for more than six months (LAC).

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC.

As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

- 1. to identify the target group of pupils, its characteristics and needs*
- 2. to plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources*
- 3. to monitor and evaluate the impact of resources*

In 2021-2022 Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais was provided with a PDG allocation of £10,350 (£5750 PDG and £4600 Early Years PDG).

At Ysgol Gymraeg Blaendulais we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Neath Port Talbot Local Authority, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding.

We have used the funding available to:

- *provide intervention and support programmes that are proven to have the greatest impact and sustainable - ELSA and Nurture programmes.*
- *develop capacity within the school to prioritise the impact on the quality of provision and outcomes*

The intended impact of the above actions is to:

- *Improve support for targeted pupils and families through intervention.*
- *Improved wellbeing and behaviour for targeted pupils.*
- *Provide improved access to an enriched curriculum for targeted pupils.*

Our plan, which includes details in respect to how we are spending the grant follows.
