Iechyd a Lles / Health and Well-being- What was life like for a child like me in Victorian times? At the beginning of our school year we will be spending quality time getting to know each other and learning how best to support each child when needed, we will be completing individual one page profiles and collaboratively working with parents to ensure each child's health and well-being is nurtured. As a class we will be exploring our emotions and how they work by developing our physical literacy skills, through various physical activities and learning new techniques. Children will be introduced to the historic story of 'Golch Rachel,' where they will be able to have the experience of comparing the daily routine of Rachel to their class routine. The children will then produce a recount on the story using different formats. The children will have the opportunity to explore the Victorian era and discuss with their peers how different life was for Rachel. The children will also have an opportunity to contact a historian is St. Fagans via video call to ask questions related to our story 'Golch Rachel'. During this term the children will learn about Fairtrade, and they will have the opportunity to complete various activities. Every month the children will be introduced to 'Rights of a Child'.



Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol / Expressive Arts- What does Autumn look like?- During this term the children will learn about animals which hibernate and be introduced to the story 'Don't hog the hedge' in the style of Pie Corbett. The children will be able to design and create their own masks for their performance. They will have the opportunity to perform and showcase their talents and also experiment with instruments. The children will learn their colour and experiment with mixing Autumnal colours together. The children will be learning new skills through Adobe Spark where they will create their images of the animals and develop their digital competency skills. Children will regularly connect and communicate through daily circle time and develop their Welsh language skills through 'Patwrwm Iaith yr Wythnos'. During forest school sessions, the children will be designing and making a home for the hedgehog using natural materials. We will also be learning about Harvest and how we celebrate including a performance in a school concert. The children will be learning about staying safe online through various tasks during this term. The children will explore units of measurements to gain understanding of size. The children will take part in a virtual art session.



Y Dyniaethau / Humanities – What is special about Patagonia?- We will explore different cultures and beliefs and, we will support this by acknowledging different celebrations from all around the world, such as: Diwali, Remembrance Sunday, and Christmas. The children will learn how Diwali is celebrated and how it compares to the celebrations in other countries. We will give the children opportunities to watch a video and learn further about the beliefs of others. The children will be promoting children in need by creating a digital poster informing pupils in school of events during the day. The children will explore the map of the world and look closely at where most of the money is distributed around the world. We will be learning all about the history of Daniel Evans who travelled to Patagonia. We will be reading the book 'Daniel Evans ym Mhatangonia'. In the story, the ship which they sailed on was the Mimosa. The children will be designing and making their own 'junk model' boat using recycled rubbish and will have the opportunity to have a boat race with their friends just like the boat sailed in the story. We will also be discussing and writing instruction of how to build a boat.



Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg / Science & Technology- How do things work?

The children will be learning about Christmas this term. We will be holding a science workshop where the children will be creating their very own circuits and learn about electricity. The children will also be creating a pictogram on JIT in order to develop their ICT skills. They will also have an opportunity to complete various science experiments including freezing and melting and also make snow.

Y Pedwar Diben / Four Purposes –

- During our time in class, there will be a strong emphasis on gaining independence for the children. Examples of this being; getting their own fruit and drink during snack time, putting on their coat independently. Independence will enable the children to be ambitious, capable learners.
- The children will explore different religions and belief from all around the world. In order to understand this, we will be acknowledging different celebrations from around the world, whilst becoming ethical, informed citizens.
- The children will be healthy, confident individuals by utilising forest school and given the opportunity to explore and become independent learners.
- The children will develop their enterprising skills, by setting up their own Christmas Post Office, where they will be able to sell and buy items and become creative contributors.
